





How to make a



STEP 1

Gather your supplies.
To make a book you will need scissors, a printed template, and your favorite art supplies (pencil, felt-tip pens, markers, colored pencils, crayons, etc.)



STEP 5

Open the page so you can see the whole paper and fold the paper again, this time "hamburger" style, with the "Draw Your Main Character" section facing up.

STEP 2

The printed template needs to be trimmed. Find the scissors icon on the "Draw Your Main Character" side of the page and follow the dotted line.

Be sure to print two-sided. If you can't do that, you can print two pages and tape them back to back. If taping, look for the target mark and line up the front and back page accordingly.



STEP 6

Open the page and flip it over in your hand so it makes the letter "V". Fold each side of the paper in half to make the letter "M".



STEP 7.1

Open the entire page again and find the dotted line that goes up the center of the paper 3/4 of the way. Cut the center of the paper along the dotted line.




STEP 4

With the "DrawYour Main Character" side of the page facing up, fold the paper "hot dog style."





You are only only cutting your paper 3/4 of the way, not all the way!




