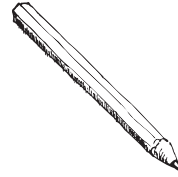
Smell-e-Vision

READY, SET... ART!

- ◆ Look closely at these two works of art!
- ◆ Discuss and describe real and imagined smells in both works!
- ◆ Write on your paper three smells and what they make you think of for each artwork (6 total)!



REMEMBER! Smells can be what the artwork **actually** smells like, or what the artist wants you to **imagine** it smells like!

WRAP UP!

Go around the classroom and ask students to share one word they used to describe a artwork through smell.

Write the words on the board and circle the most commonly used.

Use the words on the board as inspiration for a writing exercise of the teacher's choice (joke, limerick, poem, haiku, sentence, or paragraph).
