What is LINE?

EXPLORE LINE!


"A LINE is a dot that went for a walk." - Paul Klee

LINE: A mark with greater length than width. Lines can be horizontal, vertical, or diagonal; straight or curved; Thick or thin.

Spend a couple of minutes looking closely at a work of art! (see next slide)

How many different lines do you see? How would you describe them?








READY, SET... ART!

- ◆ On a piece of paper draw a U-shape near the bottom of the paper.
- ◆ Next, choose 5 different kinds of lines to grow out of the U-shape.
- ◆ Repeat each line 5 times to fill up the whole space of the paper.
- ◆ Add a neck, shoulders, and a face to create a self-portrait on a crazy hair day!
